Ruby's Rainbow Scholarship Applications are evaluated by our Selection Committee based on five categories: **Personal, Accomplishments, Goals, Community Impact** and **Extras**. Applicants may be awarded 0–3 points in each of these categories based on the following criteria:

Personal: <i>Personality, interests, values, hobbies, passions, and hopes for the future – what makes YOU unique!</i>	<p>The applicant has provided a full picture of their personality, interests, and values. They have richly demonstrated what is important to them by sharing their hobbies, passions, and/or hopes for the future. Their unique voice and spirit shine through as they provide a clear vision of their life, individuality, and what makes them unique.</p>	<p>The applicant has provided some information about their personality, interests, and values. They have shared hobbies, passions, and/or hopes for the future that demonstrate a general sense of their life, individuality, and what makes them unique.</p>	<p>The applicant has provided little information about their personality, interests, or values. They listed some specific or ongoing examples of participating in volunteer work, advocacy/awareness efforts, or times they served in their community. Leadership or initiative may not be evident.</p>	<p>The applicant demonstrated a limited commitment to making an impact on their community by sharing few examples of volunteer work, advocacy/awareness efforts, or times they served in their community. What they shared may have been short-term or one-time events.</p>	<p>The applicant did not include any examples of volunteer work, advocacy/awareness efforts, or times they served in their community that would demonstrate any community impact.</p>
<p>Extras:</p> <p><i>Anything you can share to provide a fuller vision of YOU, including your life, interest and personality. "Extras" might include photos, videos, drawings, poems, paintings, articles, or your résumé.</i></p>	<p>The applicant has submitted at least three "Extras" in an above-and-beyond effort to provide a clear vision of their life, interests, and personality. These items might include (but are not limited to) videos, drawings, poems, paintings, photographs, articles, etc.</p>	<p>The applicant has submitted at least two "Extras" that provide general insight into their life, interests, and personality. These items might include (but are not limited to) a video, drawing, poem, painting, photograph, article, etc.</p>	<p>The applicant has submitted at least one "Extra" that provides limited insight into their life, interests, and personality. "Extras" might include (but are not limited to) a video, drawing, poem, painting, photograph, article, etc.</p>	<p>The applicant included only one "Extra" (photos, videos, artwork, etc.), and it did not provide insight into their life, interests, and personality.</p>
